## Datganiad Grant Datblygu Disgyblion a'r Grant Datblygu Disgyblion Blynyddoedd Cynnar

Diben y Grant Amddifadedd Disgyblion yw gwella canlyniadau i ddysgwyr sy'n gymwys i gael prydau ysgol am ddim a Phlant sy'n Derbyn Gofal. Bwriedir iddo oresgyn y rhwystrau ychwanegol sy'n atal dysgwyr o gefndiroedd difreintiedig rhag cyflawni eu potensial llawn.

Disgwylir i ysgolion ddefnyddio'r cyllid hwn i'r eithaf i gyflwyno strategaethau cynaliadwy fydd yn arwain yn gyflym at newidiadau i ddysgwyr sy'n gymwys i dderbyn prydau ysgol am ddim neu sy'n PMG. Fel ysgol, rydym wedi cytuno ar y tri cham canlynol:

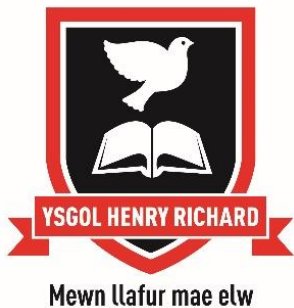
1. Adnabod grwpiau targed y disgyblion, eu nodweddion a'u hanghenion dysgu;

3. monitro a gwerthuso effaith adnoddau.

Yn 2018-19 rhoddwyd i Ysgol Henry Richard ddyraniad Grant Datblygu Disgyblion a'r Grant Datblygu Disgyblion Blynyddoedd Cynnar o £23,750.

Yn Ysgol Henry Richard mae gennym gynllun cynhwysfawr, sydd wedi'i gytuno a'i fonitro gan Awdurdod Lleol Ceredigion ac ERW, i hyrwyddo cynnydd a lleihau effaith rhwystrau i ddysgu i fyfyrwyr sy'n gymwys ar gyfer y cyllid hwn. Rydym wedi defnyddio'r cyllid sydd ar gael i:

- dargedu ymyrraeth i hyrwyddo lles a medrau allweddol disgyblion
- gefnogi teuluoedd i sicrhau bod eu plant yn cael y cyfleoedd i fynychu darpariaethau hanfodol gan gynnwys gweithgareddau allgyrsiol a rhaglenni cymorth academaidd.
- fireinio systemau olrhain data i nodi anghenion dysgwyr y grwpiau hyn, tracio eu cynnydd tuag at dargedu, ac i fonitro effaith ymyraethau yn effeithiol.
- gefnogi rôlau arweinwyr cynnydd





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## Pupil Development Grant and Early Years Pupil Development Grant Statement

The purpose of the PDG is to improve outcomes for learners eligible for free school meals (eFSM) and Looked After Children (LAC). It is intended to overcome the additional barriers that prevent learners from disadvantaged backgrounds achieving their full potential.

Schools are expected to make the best use of this funding to implement sustainable strategies that will bring about changes quickly for learners eligible for free school meals or who are LAC. To ensure the money is used appropriately we analyse data to profile our FSM and LAC learners, ensure our plans are cost effective and we monitor and evaluate the impact of what we do.

As a school we have agreed the following three steps:

1. To identify the target groups of pupils, their characteristics and learning needs;
2. To plan interventions which make the most effective use of resources;
3. To monitor and evaluate the impact of resources.

In 2018-19 Ysgol Henry Richard was allocated £23,750 through the Pupil Development Grant and Early Years Pupil Development Grant.

At Ysgol Henry Richard we have a comprehensive plan, agreed and monitored by Ceredigion Local Authority and ERW, to promote progress and remove barriers to learning for students eligible for this funding. We have used the available funding to:

- target intervention to promote pupils' welfare and key skills
- support families in ensuring their children have the opportunities to attend vital provisions including extra-curricular activities and academic support programmes.
- refine data tracking systems to identify these learners' needs, track their progress towards targets, and to monitor the impact of interventions effectively.
- support the progress leaders' roles.
